SETUP:

The show site will not be available until 8:00 am on Friday for setup. Please do not enter the building until this time

Directions:

From I-35, take exit #194B to Enid. Follow US 412 to Enid. Turn right onto US 81 (Van Buren) and travel North approximately 3 miles to Purdue Avenue (6th Traffic Light). LOOK! Check-In and Measuring Info... NEW RULE!!:

- Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. SSKC is not requiring armband stickers.
- Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class. If your dog needs to be measured, it is YOUR responsibility to have a measurement done prior to running,
- **If your dog does not have a height card your dog must get measured. We do not have a VMO at trial.**

Please make sure and CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG and do not potty your dog in the no potty zones. Dogs are not allowed in the restrooms.

COVID-19 PROCEDURES

This will probably change for the good

Everyone in the agility and crating buildings must wear CDC approved masks. Exceptions to wearing a mask are if eating, drinking or while running a dog in the rings.

Surgical masks, hand sanitizing lotion, and sprays will be provided.

Unloading vehicles in the breezeway won't be allowed in this year.

The agility building from the snack bar all the way to the north has been dedicated to overflow conformation grooming.

Crating will only be available in the agility building along the concrete strip and only as far as the snack bar. Please practice 6 ft social distancing when setting up.

Crating will be available in the adjacent building west of the agility area. Crating space will be clearly marked. Exhibitors are asked to crate in rows. These rows will be clearly marked. Please practice 6 ft social distancing when setting up crates or xpens.

Please try to stay in the agility or crating buildings areas. If going to conformation, obedience or any other area, except the restrooms, you must wear a surgical mask. They will be provided.

There will not be any vendors at this trial.

There will not be any paid volunteers at this trial. PLEASE VOLUNTEER IF AT ALL POSSIBLE. This trial will be run entirely by volunteers. We will provide a lunch each day for our volunteers.

A workers raffle will be done each day. Each volunteer will be given a ticket for working a height group in each class.

We won't be offering a club raffle in the conformation area this year.

The snack bar in the agility building will be closed all weekend. The restrooms will be open. A snack bar will be open in the conformation building. But, remember if leaving the agility buildings you must wear a surgical mask.

No MACH cakes or community shared food allowed at this trial.

Please bring your own writing utensils. We will not provide any for you to use.

Ribbons won't be self serve. Someone will put the stickers on ribbons. If you only want the sticker, please place your ribbon in a designated box.

The actual agility rings will have a 6 ft no zone barrier set up around them. There will be several gates to enter through this barrier to get to the rings.

There will be marked spots for the next three people to stand When waiting to go into the ring. These spots will be 6 ft apart.

If working as part of the table crew inside the ring please practice social distancing while sitting there.

If working as ring crew please sanitize you're chair before sitting in it.

The leash runner will be provided grabbers to pick up the leashes. The grabbers will be disinfected before each run. If running your dog you may put your leash in your pocket or clip it around your waist.

Walk-thru groups will be limited to a maximum of 25 people per group.

There won't be any briefings for the Premier/Masters/Excellent/T2B classes.

Dogs will not be measured at this trial.

Our Chief Course Builders are Dave Boyer and Tom Kotch. Anyone helping build courses this weekend should check in first with the Chief Builders before helping.

Disposable gloves will be provided for any course builders that wants to wear gloves.

Course builders are responsible for wiping down any used measuring device before and after using.

Course maps will be provided each day. Please disinfect your hands before and after taking your map(s). Practice social distancing while waiting in line to get your map(s).
